
At the end, the session's conclusions were:

NEWS IN THE NETWORK

Triangular Cooperation Project: Sustainable Agriculture with Bio-inputs

Costa Rica and Colombia launch a project to promote sustainable agriculture among coffee and avocado producers, encouraging the use of high-quality bio-inputs and reducing the use of agrochemicals. This initiative, financed by the European Union's Adelante 2 Fund, will benefit producers in the Central-Western region of Costa Rica and Eastern Antioquia in Colombia.

The project, led by Cenibiot-CENAT, the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock of Costa Rica, the Corporation for Biological Research of Colombia, and the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences (SLU), includes workshops and laboratory analysis to share and improve agricultural practices.

The Minister of Agriculture and Livestock of Costa Rica, Víctor Carvajal, highlighted the commitment to promoting bio-inputs and biocontrol agents, essential for sustainable agriculture and soil health.

The project was launched with an initial workshop that brought together 70 producers, where experiences on the use and production of bio-inputs were shared. This approach not only benefits the soil and food quality but also human health and the reduction of greenhouse gases.
